Directions to Companion MRI of Western New York

From Outside Rochester: Take **NYS Thruway (I-90)** to **Exit 46 to I-390** (toward **Rochester/Corning**). Follow signs for I-390 **North**. (Keep **left** at the fork. Go onto overpass and circle to merge onto I-390N). Go **2.8** miles. Take **exit 14 for E Henrietta Rd/RT-15A / RT-252/Jefferson Rd**. Turn **left** onto **E Henrietta Rd (RT-15A)**, go 1.4 miles then turn **left** into **White Spruce Blvd**. (The main entrance to Monroe Community College will be on your right; go past this intersection/traffic light and make your next left – **SOUTHVIEW COMMONS**) **CMRI** is located at **825 White Spruce Blvd** within the Veterinary Specialists of Rochester building (first building on the right hand side).

From the East Side of Rochester: Take **I-590 South** to **I-390 North**. Take **Exit 16 (East Henrietta Rd)**. Turn **left** onto East Henrietta Rd. Go past two traffic lights (390 overpass and Crittendon Road), then turn right at the next intersection (**White Spruce Blvd/Southview Commons**). **CMRI** is the **first building on the right** (Veterinary Specialists of Rochester/Emergency Service).

From the West Side of Rochester: Take **I-390 South** to the **EAST Henrietta Road Exit**. Turn right (Hampton Inn on your right) onto **E. Henrietta Rd**. Go past the next light (Crittendon Rd), then make your next right onto **White Spruce Blvd (Southview Commons)**. **CMRI** is the **first building on the right** (Veterinary Specialists of Rochester/Emergency Service)
